Digital Legacy - Virtual Death in the Digital World

Dealing with digital media after death is still a new concept. Who has a right to manage or inherit our digital legacy after we lose capacity or die? Like it or not we live in a world where life is more virtual, banking is done online and networking is governed by the web. Facebook, Twitter, Flickr, Google, Yahoo!, YouTube, eBay - these names, or at least the media tools they represent, are here to stay and dictate the means by which we communicate and transact with each other.

Can, or indeed, should our online persona and what flows from that be preserved for the benefit and enjoyment of future generations? What provision should be made in wills and powers of attorney for access to user names, passwords and other information needed to access digital information or assets?

The aim of this webinar is to update and inform practitioners on current attitudes and the law and highlight the potential pitfalls of failing to recognise the dangers. It will give guidance on giving advice to clients about preservation of information, preventing abuse, making provisions in wills and powers of attorney and in enabling executors to take prompt and effective action on death.
